2022

The EMS, at the beginning ESMST (European Society of Membrane Science and Technology), was founded by a group of few visionary membrains, P. Aptel from Uni. Sabatier in France, H. Strathmann from Uni. Tübingen in Germany, G. Tragardh from Lund Inst. of Technology-Food Engineering in Sweden, and E. Drioli from Uni. Naples in Italy who served as the President. The Society was registered as a legal entity at the prefecture of Toulouse in 1982.

At that time, the growing interest and the tremendous progress for Membrane Science and Technology suggested to better organize the scientific efforts at the European level.

The overall goal of the Society was (and is today) to promote education and communication among membrane scientists and technologists at the European and International level.

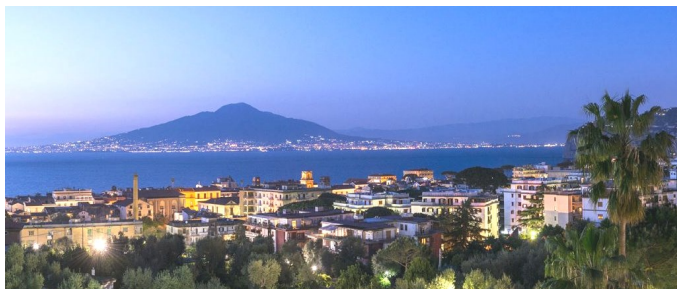

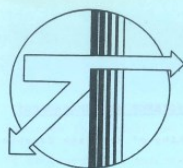
The town, with pretty pastel coloured houses and several quaint small squares is surrounded by orange and lemon groves and lush thickly wooded hills where wine and olives are grown.
